

# Installation Quick Start Guide



This *Installation Quick Start Guide* provides a brief overview of the installation process. For complete details about these procedures, see the *Cloudmark Server Edition Administrator's Guide*. You can install Cloudmark Server Edition (CSE) and its Administration Console on the same host or on separate hosts.

## CSE installation

### System requirements

Component	Minimum Requirements
Processor	Intel Pentium or compatible, 733 megahertz (MHz) or higher
Memory	256 megabytes (MB) RAM; 512 MB recommended
Operating system	Microsoft Windows Server 2000 or 2003, or Windows Small Business Server 2000 or 2003, with the latest service packs
Mail server	Microsoft Exchange 2000 Server or Microsoft Exchange Server 2003, with the latest service packs
Hard disk	20 MB for CSE software; 200 MB on the primary hard drive

## Installing CSE

### TO INSTALL CSE

- 1 Create a user for CSE, with an Exchange mailbox.
- 2 Add the CSE user to the Domain Admin group.
- 3 Grant Exchange Administrator rights to the CSE user, in the Exchange System Manager.
- 4 Shut down CSE, if an old instance is running.

- 5 Run the CSE installation program and follow its prompts.

If you also want to install the Administration Console on this host, select it on the Select Features screen. Otherwise, install it separately as explained at right.

## Administration Console installation

### System requirements

Component	Minimum Requirements
Processor	Intel Pentium or compatible, 733 megahertz (MHz) or higher
Memory	128 megabytes (MB) RAM
Operating system	Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional, Microsoft Windows 2000 Server, Microsoft Windows XP Professional or Microsoft Windows Server 2003, with the latest service packs installed
Hard disk	5 MB for installation of the Cloudmark Server Edition Administration Console

## Installing the Administration Console

### TO INSTALL THE ADMINISTRATION CONSOLE

- 1 Run the CSE installation program and follow its prompts.
- 2 On the Select Features screen, select the Administration Console.
